| Development Issue 3-1 Advancing environmental infrastructure and the capacity of management to combat environmental pollution and climate change | [Background and current situation] Following the declaration of independence in 2008, priority was given to the development of economic infrastructure, and efforts in the environmental field received comparatively less attention. However, for Kosovo, which aims to join the EU, it is essential to address environmental issues, and in recent years the development of the legal system to achieve EU standards has progressed. As the need for energy security and climate change countermeasures increases, it is necessary to further promote the development of environmental infrastructure and human resource capacity to strengthen environmental and climate change measures and facilitate the transition to clean and efficient energy. | | [Strategy] Since the formulation of policies and legal systems related to environmental measures is being carried out in accordance with EU standards in anticipation of future EU accession, it is appropriate for European donors, including the EU, to take the lead in implementing them. Coordinated with the EU's policy and legal support, Japan will cooperate in areas where Japan's comparative advantages lie (such as air pollution control, waste management, and disaster prevention), while effectively coordinating grant aid and technical cooperation with relevant stakeholders, including EU missions. In addition, while promoting cooperation within the Western Balkans region, Japan considers utilizing the advanced technologies and knowledge of Japanese private companies. | | | | | | | | | | |
